18. \_\_\_\_\_ is the island country located about 240 miles off the southeastern coast of Africa.

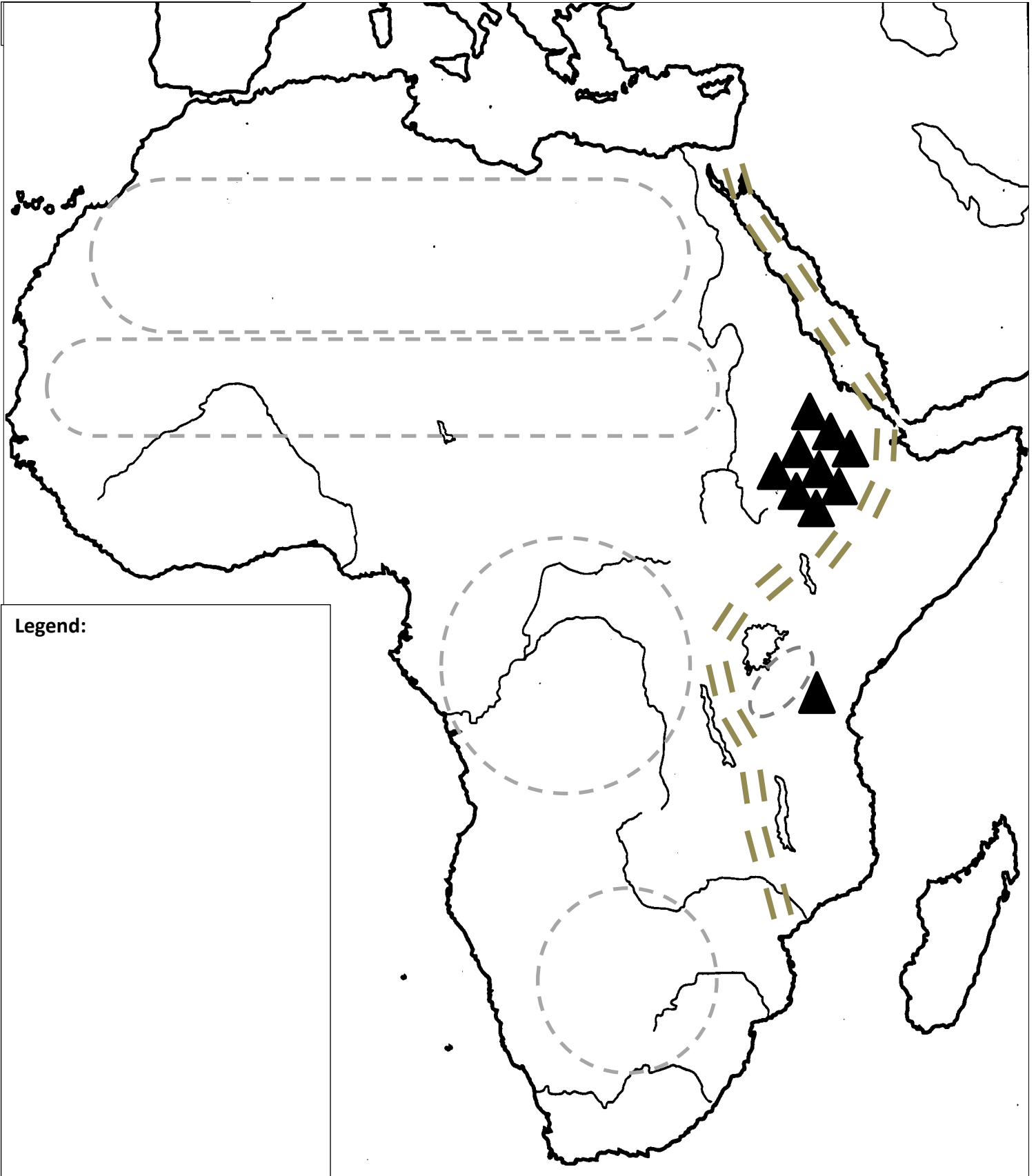
